Notes Read All Instructions Before Beginning Installation

- Only qualified mechanics experienced in the installation and removal of suspension components should perform this installation.
- Use of a hoist is highly recommended and will substantially reduce installation time.
- Never work on or under a vehicle unless it is properly supported by safety stands and wheels are blocked.
- **Never use impact wrenches** or impact guns to install or remove shock absorber piston components, shafts and piston rod nuts.
- ERL springs should be installed with part number legible and right-side-up. All original stock spring
 isolators and dampers should be retained from the stock springs and used when installing ERL springs.
- After installation, it is always important to inspect and adjust the following if necessary:- Wheel alignment such as camber, caster & toe
 - Tire and/or wheel fender clearance, when aftermarket tires and wheels are used.
 - Brake line clearance and attachments
 - Brake anti-locking and anti-skid system sensors
- Tire Rotation: In order to increase the life of your tires, it is recommended to rotate your tires every 3,000 miles
- For MacPherson Strut type front suspension, it is important to mark the orientation of the upper perch with respect to the lower perch before disassembly. This orientation must remain the same with the installation of ERL springs. Noise may result if this procedure is not performed correctly,

Instructions MacPherson Strut Style

- Remove complete strut assembly from vehicle. Removal of control arm bolts may be necessary to gain needed clearance.
- 2. Use a spring compressor on stock spring to remove tension off of upper strut mount.
- 3. Unbolt the upper strut mount and remove from assembly.
- 4. Remove stock spring and slowly loosen spring compressor.
- 5. Transfer spring compressor onto ERL spring and tighten.
- 6. Install ERL spring onto strut assembly matching the stock orientation.
- 7. Replace the upper strut mount matching the stock orientation and torque to factory torque spec.
- 8. Install strut assembly back into the car and torque all bolts to factory torque specs.

Divorced Spring and Shock Style

- 1. Install spring compressor on stock spring and tighten.
- 2. Unbolt shock or control arm bolts (if necessary) to allow enough droop for spring removal.
- 3. Remove stock spring and slowly loosen spring compressor.
- 4. Transfer spring compressor onto ERL spring and tighten.
- 5. Install ERL spring into control arm, matching the stock orientation.
- 6. Using a jack, lift up suspension to align any removed bolts and torque to factory torque specs.
- 7. Slowly loosen spring compressor and remove from ERL spring.

Eibach Limited Lifetime Warranty

All Eibach, Inc. ("Eibach") Suspension Springs, Anti- Roll-Kits, Pro-Spacers, Pro-Dampers and Pro-Truck Shocks (including Sport and Sport Leveling), Pro-Truck Coilover Systems, Pro-Alignment Kits, (collectively, "Products") are covered by a limited lifetime warranty, (the Warranty). The Warranty covers the Products against factory defects in material and workmanship, other than coatings, when used on passenger cars and light duty (class 1-3) trucks under normal use and operating conditions. These Warranties only apply to the original purchaser, who has proof of purchase and retains ownership of the vehicle on which the Products were originally installed (the "Purchaser"). Elbach, Inc. will repair, replace or refund the purchase price of the defective product at Eibach, Inc.'s sole digression, which shall fully satisfy and discharge any and all warranty claims

Exclusions from Warranty

This warranty does not apply to any products:

- That have been improperly installed or have not been properly installed by a qualified, licensed auto mechanic experienced in the installation and removal of suspension products.
- That have been improperly serviced, that have been misused, or that have been
- modified, altered or subjected to abuse, negligence, accident or collision.
- Installed on any vehicle that has carried loads in excess of automobile manufacturer suggested weight limits.
- Installed on any vehicle that has been used for rallying, racing or racing-type activities or off-road use.
- Presented for warranty coverage by a person other than the purchaser
- Presented for warranty coverage after being used on a vehicle other than the one on which it was originally installed

Eibach reserves the right to make changes in design, materials and specifications, and to make changes to Products without prior notice. Eibach does not assume any obligation to modify any previously manufactured Products.

This Warranty is the entire and only Warranty for the Products and may not be modified or supplemented by any other person or company in any form. Warranty Claim Procedure

Any and all returns must be accompanied by (1) an RGA number, (2) a sales receipt verifying the purchase of the Products, and (3) a statement containing the Purchaser's name, address, make and model of the vehicle, and a brief description of the claimed defect, including the circumstances under which the defect occurred.
